**PLAYING SITE TELEPHONE No. (732) 634-9697**

**DIRECTIONS:** From N.J. Turnpike Exit 12: Continue off ramp, bearing right onto Roosevelt Ave. Follow Roosevelt to third light: turn left onto Blair Rd. Continue 2-½ miles until Blair merges with Port Reading Ave. Continue to the right. Club is ¼ mile on right. From other routes: NJ Turnpike Exit 11, Southbound GSP Exit 129, Northbound GSP Exit 127, follow to Route 9 North. Once on Route 9, take Main St. Woodbridge Exit (Route 514). Turn right and go 1 mile to railroad overpass. Look for monument. Turn left BEFORE monument and continue on Route 514 East. Go to 2nd traffic light and turn right onto Port Reading Ave. Club is ¼ mile on left. From 287: Stay southbound, past exit 1 and NJ Tpk exit, and take 514 East exit. Stay on 514 until monument in Woodbridge, and follow above directions.
